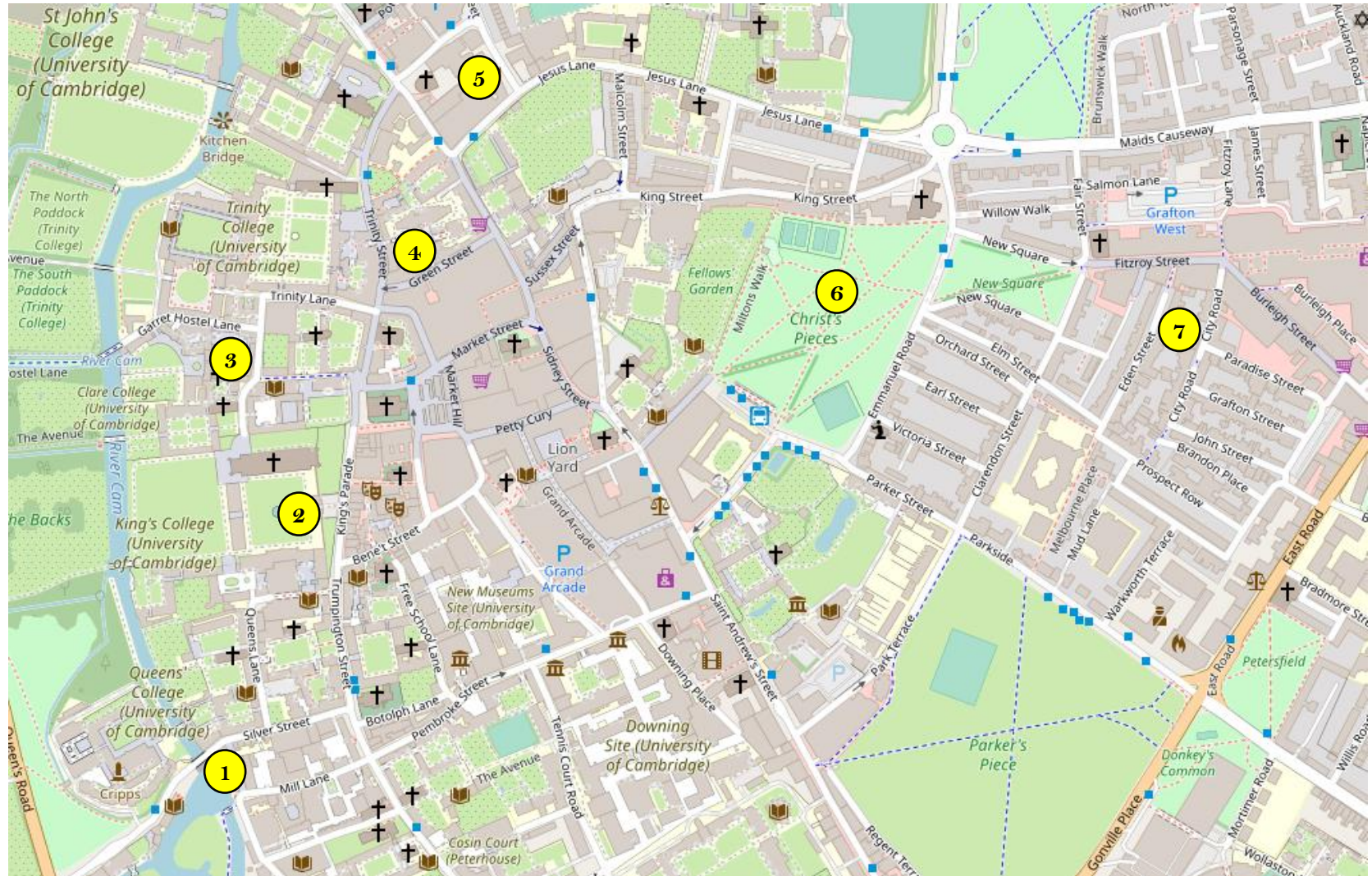


A Great Recorded History: a queer Cambridge audio trail
